Summary: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Hampton, Iowa, effective July 1, 2018.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax shall be allocated as follows:

0% for property tax relief

The specific purposes for which the revenues shall otherwise be expended are:

20% for Fire Department vehicles, equipment and facilities;

20% for the operation and maintenance of the Hampton Aquatic Center/Hampton City parks;

5% for Police Department vehicles, equipment and facilities;

55% for roads, capital improvements, operating expenses, infrastructure, equipment, economic development, public safety expenses, public buildings, or any lawful purpose.

CURRENT USES OF THE TAX:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows: 100% for the construction, equipping, operation and maintenance of an Aquatic Center.
