

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

May 4, 2009

Be it duly noted these minutes of 5/4/09 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30AM with Board members Michael Nolte-Chairman, Corey Eberling and Jerry L. Plagge present.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves the agenda as submitted with the following additions: 1) Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Central Iowa Water Association to directional bore 100th Street in Section 21 and 28, Morgan Township; 2) Consider/Adopt a Resolution asking for review of the defense of Marriage Act by the Iowa Legislature and the people of Iowa; 3) Consider/Approve Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Iowa Telecommunications Services, Inc. to place copper telephone cable along C47 west of Cardinal Avenue; 4) Consider/Approve Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Central Iowa Water Association to directional bore 100th Street in Section 21 and 28, Morgan Township; 5) Consider/Approve all Franklin County employees not covered under a collective-bargaining unit will pay \$16 dollars more a month for the cost of family health insurance beginning with premiums due July 1, 2009. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves the minutes of 4/27/09. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Board opened the meeting to public comment. No one from the public was present. Committee reports were given on: Community Action 2008 Annual Report, NIVG Board meeting and Prairie Winds RC & D meeting- going into the tree grubbing business.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Dumont Telephone Company to bury fiber optic cable in Franklin Avenue from 190th Street to 200th Street and 190th Street from Franklin Avenue east a half mile and 195th Street from Franklin Avenue to the end of the road and 200th Street from Franklin Avenue to half a mile east of Yarrow Avenue. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Qwest to bury facilities at several intersections; 70th and Nuthatch; Quail and 70th; 60th and Raven; 70th and Raven; 80th and Mallard. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves Franklin County Utility Permit Application for Qwest to bury facilities near intersection of 50th and Raven. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves an Application to Perform Work within Franklin County Highway Right-of-way for Marlyn Hofmeister to work within the road ditch along Timber Avenue in Section 8 of Osceola Township. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves a Road Closure on April 27, 2009 at 2:45 PM along 220th Street between Finch and Grouse Avenues due to impassible travel conditions to confinement operation traffic. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves a Road Closure on April 22, 2009 at 8 PM along Quail Avenue between 50th and 60th Streets due to construction traffic. Opened to traffic April 23, 2009 at 3 PM. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves a Road Closure on April 27, 2009 at 11:15 AM along Quail Avenue between 130th and 135th Streets due to washed out culverts. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves a Road Closure on April 28, 2009 at 9 AM along 35th Street between Spruce and Thrush Avenues to repair cross road culvert. Opened to traffic April 28, 2009 at 6 PM. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves a Road Closure on April 27, 2009 at 2 PM along 210th Street between Teal and Tulip Avenues because of washed out bridge embankment. Opened April 27, 2009 at 10 AM. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Eberling, approves a Road Closure on April 24, 2009 at 8:30 AM along 110th Street between Jonquil and Killdeer Avenues because of box culvert construction. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, adopts Resolution 2008-46, Revision 2; Establishing vehicle load limits and sign erection.

WHEREAS: the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 Sub.(8), 321.255 and 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit operation of vehicles or impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highway or highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: The Franklin County Engineer has caused to be completed the Structural Inventory and Appraisal of certain Franklin County bridges in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards, and it has been determined that they are inadequate for two-lane roads at allowable operating stresses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin County Board of Supervisors that vehicle and load limits be established, and that signs be erected advising of the permissible maximum weights thereof on the bridges listed, as follows:
