

April 19, 2010

Be it duly noted these minutes of 4/19/10 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30AM with Board members Corey Eberling-Chairman, Michael Nolte and Jerry L. Plagge present.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Plagge, approves the agenda as submitted with one addition: 1) Consider a Franklin County Utility Permit for Franklin REC to trench underground electric cable across the road at 1390 95th Street for a new house. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, approves the minutes of 4/13/2010. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Board opened the meeting to public comment: Ron Dunt-Hampton City Administrator inquired about the bill from the Drainage Engineer regarding investigative work in DD #45. Dunt was asking if the bill from the Drainage Engineer could be shared between the County, City and FCDA. The Board responded; the County's drainage policy states whoever requests an investigation be done and the results from the study find there are no problems to repair, those requesting the investigation shall pay for it. Dunt will address this with the City's Finance Committee tomorrow night and report back to the Board next week.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, approves an Application to Perform Work within Franklin County Highway Right-of-Way for Mark McDowell to clean the ditch along Teal Avenue approximately half mile south of 210th Street. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, approves an Application to Perform Work within Franklin County Highway Right-of-Way for Robert T. Hamilton to clean the ditch in the southeast corner of 30th Street and Mallard Avenue. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Plagge, approves setting May 14, 2010 at 2:00PM for a bid letting and May 17, 2010 for a Public Hearing for the proposed 140th Street Paving Project between Highway 65 and Mallard Avenue. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves a Contract and Bond from Peterson Contractors, Inc. for Project L-09-161—73-35 for the construction of twin RCB on 60th Street west of Vine Avenue. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Plagge, approves plans for projects L-09-152(4)—RI-35 for construction of HMA paving along Vine Avenue south of S56 and north of the tracks; L-00-067(3)—RI-35 for HMA Resurfacing along the existing paved route through Bradford; L-00-122(2)—RI-35 for HMA resurfacing

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of Raven Avenue from 70th Street to south of 60th Street; LFM-01-312(5)N2—RI-35 for HMA Resurfacing of S25 from Hardin Road to S13. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Plagge, approves construction of a sub drain within the Franklin County road right of way to Ken and Deb Mutschler at 451 Vine Avenue, Section 15 & 16, Township 90 North, Range 19 West. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, approves a Franklin County Utility Permit application to Franklin REC to trench underground electric cable across the road at 1390 95th Street for a new house. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Plagge, approves claims for the period ending 4/18/2010. All ayes. Motion carried.

At 9:30 AM Tony Reed – Central Iowa Detention Center, Eldora, Iowa, met with the Board to discuss a possible Juvenile Detention – 28E Agreement. Also present was: Dan Weichmann-County Attorney. Mr. Reed explained the services provided to Franklin County were transportation, tracking and monitoring, drug testing, detention and multiple other services. One advantage of entering into an Agreement is the traveling time is only 35 minutes from Hampton to Eldora. Supervisor Plagge asked to tour the facility before signing a 28E Agreement. No action taken.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Plagge, approves an Application for Disabled Veteran’s Homestead Tax Credit on a parcel described as the North 120’ of E ½ Block 2, Harriman’s Addition. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, agrees to sign the Wellmark Permission to Decline Outpatient X-Ray and Laboratory Claims Processing Changes. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, approves a Cigarette and Tobacco Permit for Gorder’s Service and Café, Bradford, Iowa from July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011. All ayes. Motion carried.

The Board acknowledged receipt of an email from The Baker Group regarding cooling issues in the IT area and possible geothermal for the new Sheriff’s building. No action taken.

Motion by Plagge, seconded by Nolte, adjourns at 10:35 AM, until April 26, 2010. All ayes. Motion carried.
