

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

February 21, 2017

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30AM with Board members Gary McVicker-Chairman, Michael Nolte and Corey Eberling present.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, approves the agenda as submitted. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves the minutes of 2/13/17. All ayes. Motion carried.

Committee Updates: Central Iowa Juvenile Detention Center; Franklin County Development Association; Joint Drainage District #4-118; Central Iowa Community Service; and Conservation

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, adopts Resolution 2017-09: Bridge Embargo. Said Resolution reads below:

WHEREAS: the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 Sub.(8), 321.255 and 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit operation of vehicles or impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highway or highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: The Franklin County Engineer has caused to be completed the Structural Inventory and Appraisal of certain Franklin County bridges in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards, and it has been determined that they are inadequate for two-lane roads at allowable operating stresses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin County Board of Supervisors that vehicle and load limits be established, and that signs be erected advising of the permissible maximum weights thereof on the bridges listed, as follows:

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves Plans, Specifications and Form of Contract for BROS-C035(94)—8J-35, RCB Culvert Replacement – Triple Box on Lark Avenue between 210th and 220th Street over Drainage District No. 55 to be let on May 16, 2017 pending renewal of US Army Corps of Engineers Nationwide Permit No. 14 in March, 2017. All ayes. Motion carried.

Sue Wulf-Flint requested funding for the La Luz Gran Festival. No action taken.

Heather Bushbaum, Deputy Recorder, requested an amendment of Recorders FY16/17 budgeted expenditures for transition of scanning software. The Board agreed to allow.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, adopts Resolution 2017-05: Franklin County Board adopts the salary recommendations for elected officials for FY beginning 7/1/17, as recommended by the County Compensation Board; with the reduction of the Supervisor's wage by half of the recommendation. Said resolution reads as follows:

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Compensation Board meets annually to recommend a compensation schedule for elected officials for the fiscal year immediately following, in accordance with Iowa Code Chapters 331.905 and 331.907, and WHEREAS, the Franklin County Compensation Board met on February, 21, 2017, and made the following salary recommendations for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Franklin County Board of Supervisors adopts the salary recommendations above for elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 as recommended by the Franklin County Compensation Board; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Compensation Board met on February, 21, 2017, and made the following salary recommendation for the County Supervisors for fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017, and the Supervisors reduced their amount recommended by half from a \$700 increase to a \$350 increase;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Franklin County Board of Supervisors approves the following salary adjustment for the following elected officials for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017:
