

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

April 3, 2017

Be it duly noted these minutes of 4/03/17 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:33AM with Board members Gary McVicker-Chairman present, Corey Eberling-present via phone and Michael Nolte-absent.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves the agenda as submitted. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves the minutes of 3/27/17. All ayes. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Tammy Morris-1440 170th Street, Hampton, west of the railroad by Beed's Lake conveyed concern with the abundance of gravel in her ditch from the winter snow removal. Morris is checking on the date that the excess rock was moved into her ditch and report to the County Engineer to check on the speed traveled on said day. No action taken.

Jim Zacharias was requesting that Veteran's Affairs use tax payer dollars to fund a scholarship program in Franklin County. The Board will investigate.

Lawrence Meyer, Latimer City Council, was requesting the County help fund 1/3 of a blacktop project in the City of Latimer from the bus barn to the elevator east driveway north on Heather Avenue. The Board will investigate.

Committee Updates: First Security 4th Annual Forum, Access, Inc., FCDA Industrial Park internet upgrade

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves an Application to Perform Work within Franklin County Highway Right-of-Way for Dennis Abbas to place intake and tile in east ditch of Killdeer Avenue at cross road culvert approximately 1000 feet north of 160th Street. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves Application to Perform Work within Franklin County Highway Right-of-Way for Jay Behn to place intake and tile in west ditch of Quail Avenue at cross road culvert approximately 300 feet south of 200th Street. All ayes. Motion carried.

Troy Weary – ITC Midwest Area Manager updated the Board on ITC current project installation in Franklin County. ITC has a punch list in place for finishing up the said project. They appreciate the patience of the County and help from the County Engineer. Weary announced a public meeting will be held on April 20, 5:30 PM at Latimer Community Center for anyone interested in ITC's progress. Completion date will depend on the weather conditions today and in the future.

At 10:00 AM the Board opened sealed bids for Law Library Volumes and bids were granted to the high bidders.

At 11:00 AM Jim Meyer, Landowner of parcel 0733176028 located west of Hampton on the east side of the railroad, was present to discuss DD#45, Lateral 1 possible broken tile issues.

Also present was: Sandy Eckhardt, Drainage Clerk

DD #45, Lat 1 runs under his building and surface water is causing an 8" wash out under said building which has resulted in the inside cement floor to collapse. Eckhardt stated she didn't know that anyone has checked the drainage on the west. This problem will be forwarded on the Drainage Engineer, Lee Gallentine, and past records will be investigated. No action taken.

The Board reviewed a Non-permitted Animal Feeding Operation construction application for Guy Site, owner Mark & Linda Guy, site located NW ¼ SW ¼, Sec 28, Hamilton Twp. No action taken.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, approves a Fireworks Permit to Don Ziesman to display on April 14, 2017 at 325 Finch Ave, Alden, IA. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by McVicker, adjourns at 11:21 AM, until April 10, 2017. All ayes. Motion carried.
