

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

January 15, 2018

Be it duly noted these minutes of 1/15/18 are UNOFFICIAL minutes.

The Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 8:30AM with Board members Gary McVicker-Chairman, Michael Nolte and Corey Eberling present.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves the agenda as submitted with the addition of: 1) Consider/Approve claims; and 2) Utility Permit on 30th Street (Old Goat Barn). All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, approves the minutes of 1/8/18. All ayes. Motion carried.

Gabe Johanns presented concerns with the Courthouse key lock system and possible camera system.

Committee Updates: NIACOG, NIVC, HAZMAT, Transportation, Tourism

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, adopts Resolution 2018-06: Weight Limitations. Resolution reads as follows:
WHEREAS: the Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.236 Sub.(8), 321.255 and 321.471 to 321.473 to prohibit operation of vehicles or impose limitations as to the weight thereof on designated highway or highway structures under their jurisdiction, and

WHEREAS: The Franklin County Engineer has caused to be completed the Structural Inventory and Appraisal of certain Franklin County bridges in accordance with the National Bridge Inspection Standards, and it has been determined that they are inadequate for two-lane roads at allowable operating stresses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Franklin County Board of Supervisors that vehicle and load limits be established, and that signs be erected advising of the permissible maximum weights thereof on the bridges listed, as follows:

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves a Utility Permit Application for Iowa Regional Utilities Association, Newton, Iowa for a road crossing north & south under 30th Street between Sections 27 & 34, Osceola Township, to install a 3" water main. All ayes, motion carried.

Lisa Flack, Planning and Zoning Coordinator, met to request the Board consider the amending of Ordinance 6.1-8 to Ordinance 6.1-9 based on the December 26, 2017 Public Hearing changing the zoning from A-1 Ag to C-1 Commercial in Section 31, Mott Township.

Present was: Brad Staley

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, moves to waive the first and second readings to amend Ordinance 6.1-8 and adopt Zoning Ordinance 6.1-9, amending Section 9 to change the zoning from A-1 Ag to C-1 Commercial on property described as NE ¼ NE ¼, excepting the railroad ROW in Section 31, Mott Township, containing 34.43 acres and proceeding directly to the third and final reading. All ayes. Motion carried.

Supervisor McVicker read the amendment.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, repeals Ordinance 6.1-8 and approves zoning change and adoption of Ordinance 6.1-9 per recommendation of the P&Z Commission, amending Section 9 to change the zoning on the following parcel from A-1 Ag to C-1 Commercial: NE ¼ NE ¼ Sec 31, Mott Township, Containing 34.43 acres. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, postpones the decision to grant a subdivision waiver to Dogwood Farms, LLC, to create Parcel D in NE ¼ of Section 26, Grant Township, until the owners are present to explain the reason for the land division and the timely steps not taken per Iowa Code and Franklin County Ordinances. All ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Eberling, seconded by Nolte, approves claims for period ending 1/14/18. All ayes, motion carried.

The Board acknowledged the Sheriff's 2017 December Report of Fees Collected and Quarterly Report from 10/1/17-12/31/17.

Motion by Nolte, seconded by Eberling, adjourns at 2:46 PM, until January 22, 2018. All ayes. Motion carried.
