FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 10.1

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE READOPTING THE EXISTING COUNTY CODE AND REPEALING FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 10.1 AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO, FRANKLIN COUNTY, IOWA.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin County, Iowa:

Section 1. Purpose. Code of Iowa section 331.302(9), requires that once every five years a County shall compile its Code of Ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in affect, adopts ordinances that become effective after the last readopting and repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Franklin County, Iowa or the health, safety, and welfare of its' citizens.
