ORDINANCE NO. 10.1

**AN ORDINANCE READOPTING THE EXISTING COUNTY CODE AND REPEALING
FRANKLIN COUNTY ORDINANCE 10.1 AND ALL AMENDMENTS THERETO,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, IOWA**

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Franklin County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Purpose. *Code of Iowa* Section 331.302(9), requires that once every five years a County shall compile its Code of Ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in affect, adopts ordinances that become effective after the last readopting and repeals any ordinance deemed no longer necessary to the operation of Franklin County, Iowa or the health, safety, and welfare of its' citizens.

SECTION 2. Readopting of Current Code. The following ordinances have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the laws provides. SECTION 3. Code of Ordinances. Copies of the code as adopted herein shall be on file and available for public inspection in the Office of the County Auditor at the Franklin County Courthouse.

SECTION 4. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. Severability Clause. If any section, provision, or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not invalid or unconstitutional.
